CPCS POLICY ON LIABILITY FOR THEFT OR LOSS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

Connections Public Charter School shall not be liable for theft or loss of personal property on school grounds. Should students choose to bring personal belongings to school, the students, not the school, are responsible for ensuring that their belongings are secured.

The school takes reasonable precautions to ensure the general security of property within the Kress Building.

Students are discouraged from bringing valuable belongings to school. Valuable belongings include cash, expensive electronic or digital equipment, expensive clothing, jewelry, etc. Should students choose to bring such items to school, they do so at their own risk.

Parents or guardians should take steps to ensure that any valuable items are appropriately covered under their homeowners insurance or renters insurance.

Where appropriate, the school will report to authorities and prosecute all thefts or vandalism to property.
